2. 4th Grade Student Information: Please complete the 4th Grade Student Information sheet. (This can be found inside your child's Monday Folder within the "Parent Information" pocket.) Often, teachers do not hear from parents until conferences in November. We would like to start our dialogue now. Complete and return this form to your child's classroom teacher by Friday, September 12th.
3. Manila Envelope for Driscoll Office: Sometime in the next few weeks, your child will bring home a large manila envelope with forms for the main office. Please fill out all of the forms and send it back to your child's classroom teacher.
4. Grade 4 Conservatory Letter: Please read the letter sent to you from Kenny Kozol, K-12 Performing Arts Curriculum Coordinator, complete it, and return it to your student's classroom teacher by this Wednesday, September 10th.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

5. Weekly Schedule \& 4th Grade Fees: Fourth grade students do not need to bring any school supplies from home except a small pencil case of their choosing. All materials have been ordered from W.B. Mason. Costs for field trips and supplies will be discussed at Open House.
6. Nut Free Classroom: All classrooms at Driscoll School are nut-free. Please check to make sure snacks DO NOT contain any nut ingredients. They may bring items containing nuts for lunch. For all new students, please make sure you include all allergies and/or medications on the student form and be in touch with Nurse Dewing.
7. K-5 Open House is on Thursday, October 2 nd . This is a time where parents get to come into their child's classroom, meet the teacher, and hear about the curriculum, routines, and other important information. We strongly encourage you all to attend. If you are unable to attend Open House, we can try our best to send some information home to you, but you will miss some information if not present. (The specific hour timeslot will be announced soon.)
8. Room Parents: We are looking for 1-2 room parents for each 4th grade classroom. Responsibilities include communicating between PTO and 4th grade parents, planning our first field trip and a few other small things. Please let us know if you're interested!
9. Attendance: Students arriving to school before 7:50am should proceed to the cafeteria. At 7:50am, students are dismissed from the cafeteria and are allowed to be in the hallway walking to their classroom, as they are expected to be ready to walk through their classroom door at 7:55 so they're ready for class to begin at 8:00am. Any student entering the classroom after 8:00am will be asked to get a late pass from the main office, so please help your student arrive by 7:50 each morning, prepared for the day ahead. Please email your student's classroom teacher when they are going to be tardy, absent, or have to leave before dismissal.
10. Driscoll Library: Beginning the week of September 15, the Driscoll Library will be open for students. Each fourth grade class goes to the library once a week during the school day. The library is also open the following times: 7:50am each morning; until 2:45pm on Mondays and Tuesdays; and until 3:00pm on Wednesdays and Thursdays. (On Friday, the library closes at 1:40 dismissal.)
